Departments “J, L, M, O, P” General Rules to Cover Departments J through P

General Superintendent:

All residency requirements are lifted. Anyone from any county may enter. However, those persons who have or work in a business or provide services (such as teaching that area, receiving money from flea markets or craft shows, or advertise and provide a service connected with this type of entry) may NOT enter those categories. If there is a question of the status of the exhibitor, please check with the General Superintendent before making your entry. If there is a question after the entry has been made a ruling will be made by the Superintendent with the aid of the Fair Board.

Entry tags will be furnished for all entries and must be attached to plate or exhibit securely, or the exhibit will be disqualified. No entry will be judged without the proper tag. To aid the exhibitors, the Fair office will be open Saturday, June 23 - Monday, June 25-27 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Beginning Thursday, June 28 the office will be open 7:30 – 10:00 p.m. so exhibitors should plan to make their entries ahead of the entry deadline, then bring and place entries at the proper times. Entries for Departments M, O, and P need to be in place before 8:30 a.m. Friday, June 29, 2012. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. Departments J and L need to be in place before 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, June 30, 2012 with no admittance during the judging. **Entries will close at 9:00 p.m. the night before judging.** The building will be open Thursday, June 28 for exhibitors to bring entries from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. Building will open on June 29 & June 30 at 7:00 a.m. for those bringing entries.

An exhibit which has won first prize in Dept. M Textiles and Fine Arts last year is ineligible to be entered this year.

An exhibitor is limited to one entry per class but may enter as many classes as they wish and qualify for. A separate entry needs to be entered in Open and Junior Dept.

No article may be entered if there is no class listed for it in the premium book and will be disqualified if in the wrong category.

All exhibitors are required to purchase an exhibitor's ticket at the cost of \$20.00 which is GOOD FOR THE ENTIRE FAIR! No refunds will be given if you don't have your exhibitor pass with you. If you make an entry and buy an exhibitor's ticket you are required to exhibit.

Entry fees for Dept. J, L, M, and O will be \$10.00 . Dept. P will be \$5.00 to be paid when entries are made. Exhibitors may enter as many Departments and Categories as they like for the entry fee of \$10.00 for Dept. J, L, M, O, and the \$5.00 fee for Dept. P.

After exhibits are placed no one will be permitted to handle them without the permission of the superintendent in charge.

In Department O – any entry not placing must be picked after 5:00 p.m., June 29 or will be discarded. Department J – any entry not placing must be picked up after 5:00 p.m., June 30 or will be discarded.

Please sign up to help watch the exhibits which will be in the Merchants Building so nothing disappears!

Release time will be Wednesday, July 4 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and any exhibitor removing entries early will forfeit all premium monies. There will be no exceptions. NO CHECKS WILL BE MAILED. Premium checks will be picked up on Wednesday, July 4. Anyone failing to pick up entries at that time will forfeit all premium monies.
