

2012 Livestock General Rules & Regulations

The Schuyler County Fair is being conducted as an open show for all livestock exhibits.

- Animals exhibited must be recorded with the respective breed associations in the name of the bona fide exhibitor to date of showing.
- Ownership: Animals owned in partnership may be enter in all classes in one owner's name, but must appear under but one ownership. The entry shall carry a footnote showing actual ownership of the animals as appearing upon the herd record books. Exhibitors in open classes must show all or part ownership of the animals shown.
- Exhibitors must furnish all water pails for watering of animals. No water tanks will be allowed. Also, each exhibitor must furnish his or her own feed for the necessary care of their animals.
- Awards will be made by single judge system. Placing will be final.
- Registration and Health Certificates must be under the care of the person in charge of the exhibit. Both will accompany entries and be checked upon entry.
- Exhibitors must submit their animals for examination by the veterinarian when so ordered by the superintendent of the department.
- Social Security number must appear on the entry form, or premium prize checks will be held by the fair office.
- Each superintendent reserves the right to manage his or her show.
- The Schuyler Fair will give adequate police protection and take such precautionary measures as are consistent in the operation of the Fair. However, the Fair Board will not be responsible to any person, individual, corporation, or association for any loss by fire, theft, or personal injury sustained by anyone through the negligence of any person or group of persons, exhibits or exhibitors.
- The directors of the Schuyler Fair reserve the right to cancel the fair and withdraw all premiums offered should unforeseen circumstances occur, which, in the judgment of the directors, would make it advisable to do so, and all premiums offered and contracts made shall be null and void.
- Exhibitors of livestock will be required to keep the stall in a neat and clean condition. All stall and pens must be cleaned daily.

Concessions

- All concessionaires on the grounds must comply with the sanitary regulations as required by the State Food and Drug Division, and the County Health Department.
- The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel any contract, if in its judgment, the business or exhibition carried on by the concessionaire, or the manner of conducting the same, is objectionable or not as represented at the time of making contract, and to have the property of the concessionaire removed from the grounds; and all payment previously made under the contract shall then be forfeited.
- No space shall be sublet to anyone, unless permission is granted by the Schuyler County Fair Board.
- Any, individual or organization operating a food concession on the fairgrounds will be obligated to the Schuyler County Fair Association in the amount of their contract.
- This amount will include all utilities used during the fair.
- **Deadline for payment is June 1st.**

- All food concession stands are required to have their own insurance coverage and must produce a certificate of insurance to the fair office before the beginning of the fair (Minimum \$1,000,000).

Special Rules and Regulations

- Premium money will be paid to exhibitors as soon as the department is judged and books balanced.
- All premium checks must be cashed within 60 days following the fair.
- Departments A, F, U, G exhibitors must purchase an Exhibitor Ticket for a price of \$10.00 which is good for the entire fair, or may pay the general admission price. J, L, M, O and P exhibitors must purchase an Exhibitor Ticket for a price of \$15.00 which is good for the entire fair, or may pay the general admission price. There must be an exhibit to accompany each exhibitor's pass purchased. No refunds will be given if exhibitor pass is not with exhibitor.
- Premiums will not be paid for any event not held.
- Social Security numbers are required on all entries. No exceptions.
- Entry fees for Dept. J, L, M, and O will be \$10.00 to be paid when entries are made. Dept. P entries pay \$5.00 when entries are made.
