2. Only exhibits which are products of the “home kitchen” will be eligible. **No prepared mixes.**
3. Great care must be taken to make the exhibit attractive, for the exhibits are first judge on appearance.
4. Cookies, candies, and bread should be displayed on paper plates with the size of the entry. **No glass plates.**
The fair cannot be responsible for china, glass, or tin plates.
5. Any entry not placing is to be picked up after 5:00 p.m., June 29, 2025, or it will be discarded.
